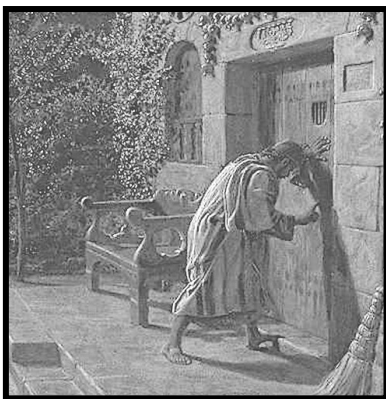

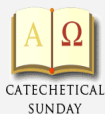
# PARISH LIFE and STEWARDSHIP

## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION ONLINE REGISTRATION (UPDATED INFORMATION)

The staff of St. Anne Parish hopes you are having a wonderful summer and that you are enjoying the beautiful weather. We would like to encourage you to go to the Parish website to register for Religious Education classes. If you haven't had the chance to visit our website you are in for a treat. Please go to <http://stannesouthborough.org/>. If you have some time please explore, look at all the great pictures of recent parish activities and browse through all the great content.

To find the Religious Education online registration form, please either click "Religious Education Registration" on the moving banner at the top of the page or go to Quick Links next to the moving banner on the right hand side under the St. Anne Parish title. You may also reach the online form by clicking on the Faith Formation tab at the very top and then follow the links after clicking on Children's Faith Formation.

Please fill in the form to the best of your ability. We've tried to answer below some questions that have come up recently regarding online registration especially those specific to students receiving sacraments this year.

Please note:

1) The Diocese of Worcester requires proof of two years of Religious Education preparation in order to be considered a candidate for the sacrament. Therefore if your child is entering 1st or 2nd grade but has not attended last year's religious education classes, please register for the combined Grade 1-2 class on either Sunday or Monday. The same would be true of a tenth grade student. A tenth grade student who did not attend preparation classes last year would register for the combined Grade 9-10 class on Sunday evenings. Students in their 1st year of preparing for the sacraments attend the combined classes this year and register for the sacrament class next year. Sacrament students are required to attend classes twice a month.

2) If your child will be receiving a sacrament this year: Please note the time and date of the Parent Meeting on September **25, 2016**. If your child is receiving First Reconciliation or First Communion please understand classes will be held on Sunday mornings from 9:00-10:30AM with the expectation the child will attend the 10:30 AM Mass with a parent when class has finished. Children will be meeting with their sacrament teachers twice a month. Again, the same is true for your high school student. If your child is receiving Confirmation, classes will be held on Sunday morning and additionally on a Sunday evening of a different week. Students in the Confirmation sacrament class will meet from 9-10:30AM with the expectation they will attend the 10:30 AM Mass as a group. The student is required to attend both classes and will be meeting with their teachers twice a month.

3) The Religious Education Fee is a drop down menu - please choose the number of children you will be registering for classes. If you have three or more children in the program the fee is capped at \$165, two children \$130 and one child is \$65. Online payment is with a credit/debit card. If you prefer to pay by another method (check/cash) please mail or drop off your check to the rectory. In the case of cash, please drop by the rectory. There will be additional fees and forms for those students receiving Sacraments this school year. Information regarding this is forthcoming.

4) A copy of your child's baptism certificate is required if they are to receive a sacrament this year. These certificates are needed before classes begin. If your child was baptized in a parish other than St. Anne, you will need to call the parish where the baptism took place and have them mail the copy or fax it to us here at 20 Boston Road, Southborough, MA 01772 - FAX number 508 481-9374.

If you would like your child to receive a sacrament this year and the child is currently in Grade 3 or above or in Grade 12 or above, please call the rectory. The child would still have to complete one year of preparation prior to the sacrament year but we will work with you regarding a class assignment.

There is no need to wait to register for classes. It would actually help us if you were to register soon, well before the parent meeting on September 25th.
