Visitation House Baby Bottle Fundraiser.

This weekend baby bottles are available for families to take to be filled with your spare money, (coins, bills, or checks). The bottles are located in the foyers of the church (families may take more than one bottle). The baby bottles should be returned at anytime but no later than the weekend of November 5th and 6th. Return the bottles to one of the empty baskets in the foyers of the Church.

Visitation House is the only private, Catholic, non-profit organization in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts that houses pregnant women in crisis. Grounded in the Gospel of Life, they are addressing the issues of homelessness and providing an alternative to the culture of death by making available:

- a welcoming, faith-filled, family home environment, where women can stay for up to 6 months after the birth of their baby
- a private room for each mom and her baby
- 3 meals a day, including a communal supper
- life skills classes taught by professionals & volunteers, including lessons in chastity, neonatal care, parenting
- individual counseling
- Bible study and monthly Mass in our chapel for those who are interested.

Visitation House is in its 11th year of operation and in that time have provided a welcoming home for over 200 women. They are continuously updating their life skills programming to meet the needs of the residents. It costs them \$22,000 per month to keep their doors open and to have caring staff members available to the residents 24/7.
