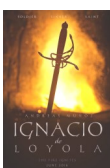

once a month at the 10:30AM Mass. Rehearsal will be in the church from 10:05AM – 10:25AM led by Paul
Crivello. Please watch this space for choir schedules. Children in Grades 1-3 attending classes Sunday morning will
be rehearsing as part of their class time.**

We are honored that you have chosen the St. Anne Parish Program to share with you the sacred responsibility of the religious education of your children.

Listed below is a look at our class schedule for the year.

Grade 1-2 - These students are in their first year of religious education preparing to receive 1st Reconciliation/1st Communion in the Spring of 2018. Classes meet Sunday morning 9-10:30AM or Monday afternoon 4-5:30PM once a month.

Grade 2 and up – These students are in their second year of religious education preparing to receive 1st Reconciliation/1st Communion in the Spring of 2017. Classes meet Sunday morning 9-10:30AM twice a month.

Grade 3 – Classes meet Sunday morning 9-10:30AM or Monday afternoon 4-5:30PM once a month.

Grade 4-5 – Classes meet Sunday afternoon 4-5:30PM or Monday afternoon 4-5:30PM once a month.

Grade 6 – Classes meet Monday evening 7-8:30PM once a month.

Grade 7-8 – Classes meet Monday evening 7-8:30PM or Tuesday afternoon 4-5:30PM once a month.

Grade 9 and Grade 10 Combined – These students are in their first/second year of Confirmation preparation. Classes meet Sunday evening 7-8:30PM once a month.

Grade 10 and up - Confirmation – These students are in their second year of Confirmation prep and will receive the Sacrament in the Spring of 2017. Classes meet Sunday morning 9 – 11:30AM once a month and includes breakfast and attendance together at the 10:30 AM Mass. These students are also required to attend the Sunday evening combined Grade 9/10 class.



YOUTH MINISTRY (Grades 6 through 8): A planning meeting is scheduled for this Sunday, October 16th at 6:00PM. We will be planning events for the upcoming Holiday Season. All Parents and students are invited.
