OCTOBER ~ RESPECT LIFE MONTH



VISITATION HOUSE: (*A warm and caring home for women facing crisis pregnancies*) We will once again support Visitation House starting this weekend, **October 9th** (*during October, the Respect Life Month*). Visitation House is a privately funded, non-profit organization in Worcester, MA that houses pregnant women in unplanned pregnancies. The home addresses issues of homelessness, poverty and abuse and provides:

- ◆ A welcoming family environment where pregnant women (18 yrs +) may stay 6 months after the birth of their baby
- ◆ A private room for each mom and her newborn baby
- ◆ 3 meals per day, including communal dinners
- ◆ Life skills classes, taught by professionals (pre/post natal care, parenting, nutrition etc.)

On the weekend of Oct. 8/9 baby bottles will be placed in the foyers of the church for parishioners to take to fill with their loose change, bills or checks. When the bottle is filled please return it to the church. The bottles will be collected intermittently during the month of October to send back to Visitation House.

OCTOBER 1917-2017**

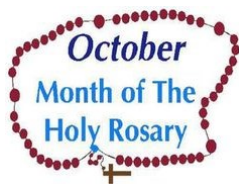
This October is not only the month of the rosary, but also the 100th Anniversary of the apparition of Mary, the Blessed Mother to the three shepherd children Sr. Lucia de Santo and her two cousins, St. Jacinta and St. Francisco, as well as the infamous miracle of the sun which was witnessed by over 1,000 people at 12:00 pm on October 13, 1917.

St. Anne's parish will be commemorating this momentous occasion of God's grace with the following events:

OCTOBER 8, SUNDAY – VIEWING OF THE MOVIE “THE 13TH DAY” ABOUT THE CHILDREN OF FATIMA AND THE APPARITIONS OF MARY, FOLLOWING THE 8:30 AM AND 10:30 AM MASSES IN THE PARISH HALL. CONTINENTAL BREAKFAST WILL BE SERVED.
