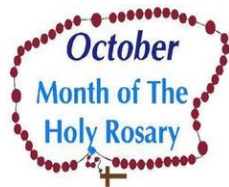
**CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION

This October is not only the month of the rosary, but also the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the apparition of Mary, the Blessed Mother to the three shepherd children Sr. Lucia de Santo and her two cousins, St. Jacinta and St. Francisco, as well as the infamous miracle of the sun which was witnessed by over 1,000 people at 12:00 pm on October 13, 1917.
